

The Twelve Ways of Earning

Money for Providence by Doing the Things You Do Everyday

Please tell your friends and family, and contact the school office or Kathryn Castle (256-8954) with any questions.

On the first day of earning money for Providence, I saved all my Campbell's labels.

Please cut out Campbell's labels and "LabelsforEducation" and put them in the Campbell's label box at school.

On the second day of earning money for Providence, I cut out BoxTops4Education coupons.

Please trim coupons neatly and put in the BoxTops4Education box at school.

On the third day of earning money for Providence, I collected used up printer cartridges and cell phones.

Return to appropriate box at school in original box or seal in plastic bag. We take cell phones, inkjet and laser cartridges, including copier cartridges. Also, if you buy cartridges through Inksmile.com, we get a 5% rebate.

On the fourth day of earning money for Providence, I bought my weekly groceries at Albertsons and Safeway.

Register online at Albertsons.com (In the Community - Community Partners) and escrip.com for Providence to receive 1%-4% of every purchase.

On the fifth day of earning money for Providence, I went shopping at my favorite store, Target!

Apply for Target's store credit card and Providence will receive 1% for every purchase made on your card. After you receive your card, register Providence as your school recipient.

On the sixth day of earning money for Providence, I got my school supplies at Office Depot.

Mention Providence Christian School (Gig Harbor) at checkout or online and Providence receives 5% of all sales.

On the seventh day of earning money for Providence, I surfed the web using GoodSearch.com.

Make sure Providence Christian School (Gig Harbor) is the in "I'm Supporting" box. Providence receives cash back for every search you make. Please make this your default search engine.

On the eighth day of earning money for Providence, I did my online shopping through Boxtops4Education.com and schoolpop.com.

If you do any shopping on-line, you can earn lots of money for Providence – up to 8% on your purchases at hundreds of popular sites including ebay.com, LandsEnd, Eddie Bauer, JCPenny, and Target. Simply register at Boxtops4Education.com and schoolpop.com. When you're ready to shop, go to Boxtops4Education.com and schoolpop.com (Use the site that gives you the best deal.) and choose the company at which you wish to shop from their list. The on-line shopping company's website will pop up just as if you had gone there directly. Do your shopping, and Providence will automatically receive money!

On the ninth day of earning money for Providence, I used my schoolpop.com VISA.

If you are interested, apply at schoolpop.com for a VISA that rewards Providence with 1% for every purchase.

On the tenth day of earning money for Providence, I bought the kids uniforms at LandsEnd.

Shop on-line, enter our code at checkout, and Providence will receive a percentage! Our code is 900089723.

On the eleventh day of earning money for Providence, I used my Washington Mutual VISA check card for WaMoola.

If you're already a Washington Mutual customer with a Washington Mutual VISA check card, every time you use your card, they will donate to Providence. Simply choose Providence as your school.

On the twelfth day I earned 50% for Providence when I bought my uniforms?!

I searched for schoolpop at GoodSearch.com,
went to LandsEnd through schoolpop.com,
entered Providence's code at checkout,
paid for my kids' uniforms with my schoolpop VISA,
used up my printer cartridge printing the receipt, and
returned it to the box at school!!!!
